Customisation Made Easy

You can embed the smart video library widget on your website with just an iframe—it comes with a clean, standard design right out of the box. But if you want it to blend in better with your site's look, there are a few simple options to customise the style. These are totally optional, but handy if you're after a more seamless appearance.

Dark Background

The widget's iframe is transparent, so your site's background will show through. If that background is dark, you can add the **dark-background** parameter. This will make any elements that sit directly on the background appear in white, so everything stays readable.

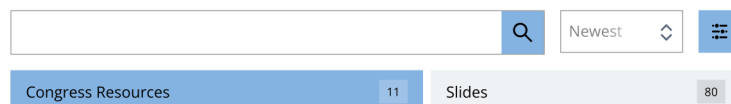
Primary Colour

Set your main accent colour using the **primary-color** parameter with a hex value (just the digits, no #). This colour will be used for things like:

- Call-to-action buttons (CTAs)
- Hover effects
- Active states



Depending on your chosen colour, the text will automatically be shown in black or white to keep contrast high.

Secondary Colour

The **secondary-color** parameter works just like the primary one but is used for different elements, such as topic labels.



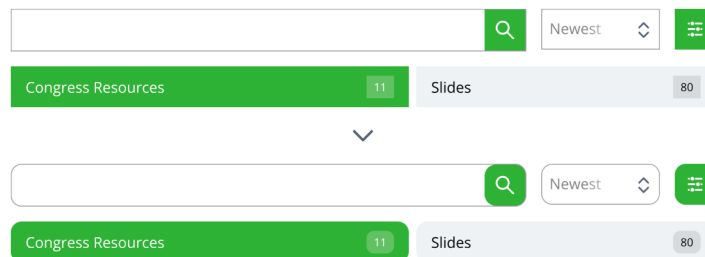
The system will again pick white or black text based on what looks best on the colour you choose.

Corner Rounding (Border Radius)

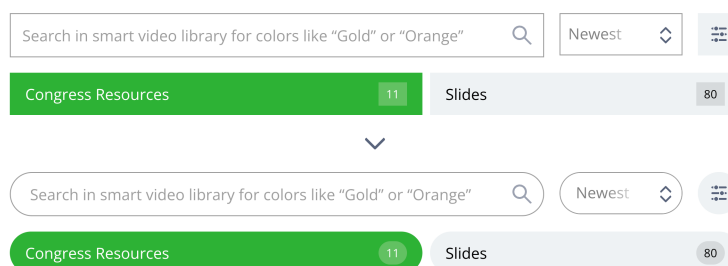
By default, all elements have sharp corners. If you'd like a softer look, you can set the **border-radius** parameter with a pixel value (without px). This affects the roundness of tiles in the library and will also apply to other UI elements for a consistent feel.

Pill Shape

When the **pill-shape** option is turned on, buttons and other elements get smooth, rounded ends—like a pill. This setting makes the short sides fully curved, no matter what border radius is set.
